

The Modesty Diagram

The What

Hello. If you're reading this, you've probably been issued a friendly challenge to support your views on modesty with biblical passages. Just in case, here's how it works:

Identify a part of the body you believe ought to be concealed from view. Draw a line from that part of the body toward one of the page margins, and at the end of the line, write down the reference to a verse or passage that requires that part of the body be concealed.

Feel free to modify the image to your heart's content. Fun idea: Color each concealed part of the body in a different color! Color the chest red, the belly blue, et cetera, et cetera.

If you're right about concealing the body, then this diagram represents a perfect opportunity for you to demonstrate that with Scripture. If you turn out to be mistaken about the content of Scripture, don't fret! When we find ourselves wrong about the Bible, it's a door being thrown open for us to understand Scripture and its Author on a new and improved level. If your results surprise you, then share them! Chances are pretty good that your friends will find them surprising, too.
